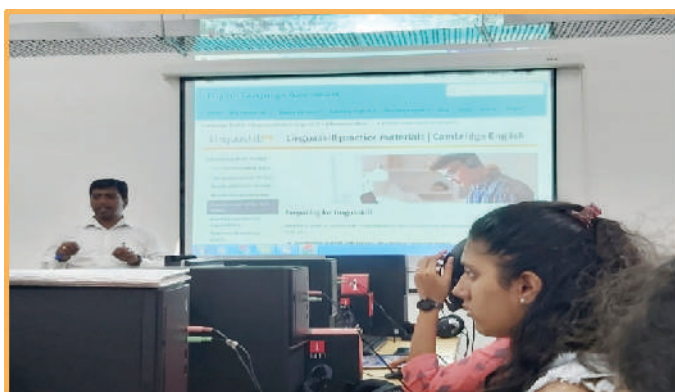

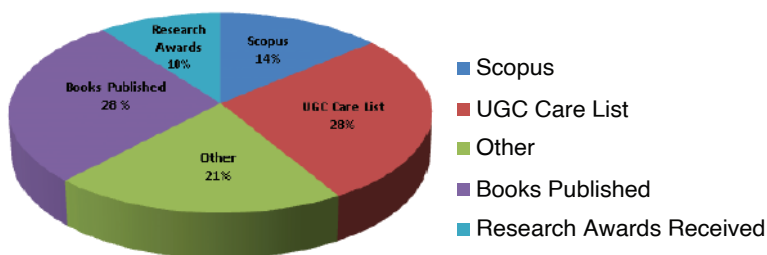

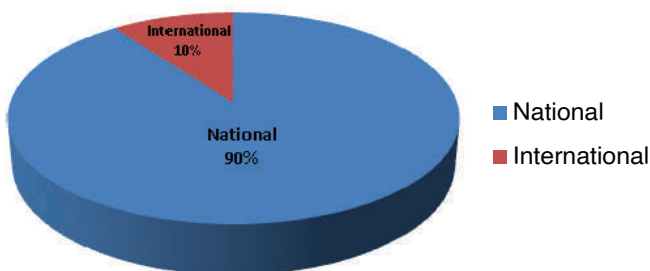


Research papers & Books Published by Faculty

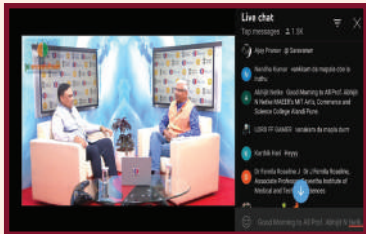

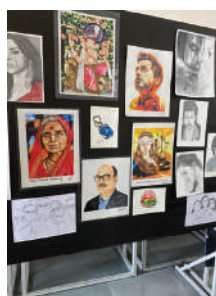
ART AND CRAFT EXHIBITION

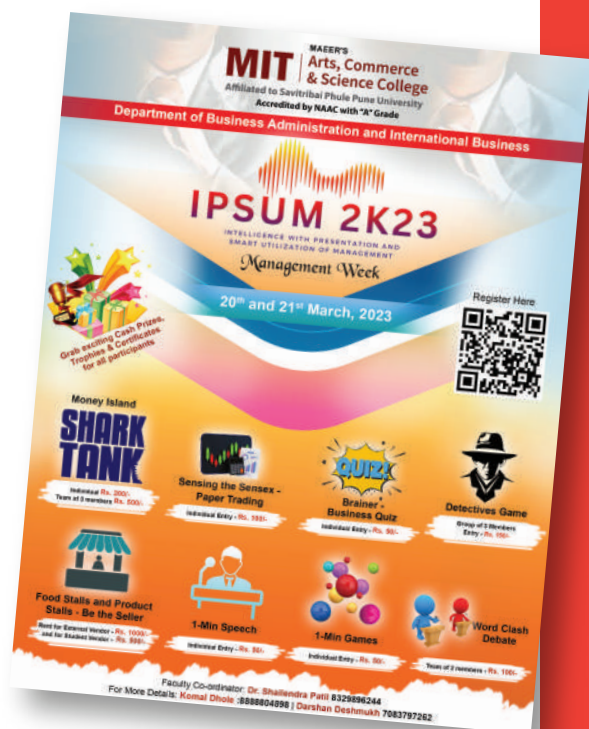
IPSUM - 2K23
