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About Library

An Academic Library is truly a learning center, which aims to serve the needs of faculty, students and research scholars. Our library is well-equipped and well managed. It is the center of knowledge which continuously contributes in the intellectual as well as all-round development of its users and it inspires them to achieve goals in their lives. Total area of library is 7446 Sq.ft. The Library aims to provide a user-friendly platform to all users to access print and online resources without any hassle through AutoLib Web OPAC along with remote access facility. The library is fully automated with AutoLib software for daily housekeeping operations of the library across the campuses. Currently, MIT ACSC Library has more than 9785 print books, 69 print journals, 561 CD/DVDs, more than 7,172 e-journals, around 31,35,000 e-books. The library conducts various activities such as library orientation sessions, expert guidance, and demo presentation to access e-facilities. The Best Reader award and Library week are the initiatives taken by the library to motivate students to read. Under Library week, various competitions like quiz, paper presentation, poster presentation, book and article review, debates etc. are organized to broaden students' knowledge horizon and to make them competent to face global challenges.

Library Collection

Central Library is constantly making efforts to increase the collection in both print and electronic form and also takes efforts to its maximum utilization providing open access to all collection and digital library facility free of cost to all staff and students. This year library collection reached up to 9785. Time to time library conducts various activities for readers. Library also promotes readers to read and write as well and publish.
