

Dr. Vishwanath Karad Merit Scholarship Policy for First Year Students of All Programs

Objective

To provide guiding document to award merit scholarship for first year students of all programs.

Eligibility

First year students of all Under Graduate & Post Graduate programs.
(Refer Annexure-I & Annexure-II for details)

Merit Scholarship Policy

- This scholarship provides 10% / 15% / 20% of college fees waiver for the first year students only, subject to fulfilment of terms & conditions updated from time to time by the College.
- This scholarship shall be awarded to eligible students only.

Terms & Conditions to Award Merit Scholarship

- This scholarship is valid for the academic year 2026–2027.
- The scholarship will not be given in cash but will be adjusted in college fees.
- In case of cancellation of admission, the scholarship would stand 'null & void' and the student has to pay complete/full fees for that year; only then the student will be issued with Transfer Certificate / Migration Certificate / Transcript / refund etc., as applicable.
- To avail the scholarship, it would be mandatory for the student to apply for the scholarship by filling the scholarship application form.
- The application for scholarship shall be scrutinized as per the Scholarship Scrutiny procedure of the college, updated from time to time.
- This policy is applicable to the students who have passed their 12th examination / UG examination in the year 2026. (Students who have education gap after qualifying examinations are not eligible for this scholarship scheme.)
- If a student is eligible for multiple scholarships or any other concession, in that case only one benefit will be considered and granted to the student.
- Scholarship and concession is applicable only for first year college student.
