4.2. <u>Remuneration</u>:

4.2.1. It has been agreed to the Parties that the Remuneration for the said training program shall be Rs. 2,700/- (Rupees Two thousand and seven hundred only) per Trainee and **Party of the FIRST PART** shall receive such Remuneration from trainee.
