Motive behind organizing this trip was to provide the practical exposure to the students of TYBCOM in the field of Commerce and Management

Students of TY BCOM (47) actively participated in this study tour.

Tour started in the early morning at 6.30 am in the Aim of one day return, reached to the destination around 10.30 am , 125 km approx. from the college campus.

Students were provided with a spacious bus and were accompanied by the staff members of Dept of BA and BCOM.

Students were taken to the sugar factory (*Malegaon sahakari sakhā karkhana*) after their breakfast.

They observed the various processes involved in sugar making very keenly .After that they were taken to Linen and Cotton king textile industry in textile park,8 km away approx from the destination.

Students studied the finishing process of the textile product in textile industry.

Students returned to the *Agri- tourism centre* to have lunch . After having healthy food , boys and girls students enjoyed *The Tractor Ride* ,where they examined various kinds of farming processes and its up gradations. It was fully a natural ride in the farm around 110 acre. Students also got to know various processes involved in farming like Horticulture, Dairy Farm, Floriculture and Animal Husbandry etc. Students and the staff returned to the college campus around 9.30pm with the enlightenment of a fruitful study tour


We offer Bullock cart, Tractor Rides, dairy unit visit, we have facilities for overnight stay for up to 150 students. Details are enclosed on activates for your children.

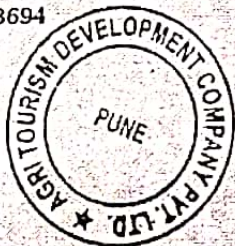
