


3rd International Yoga Day

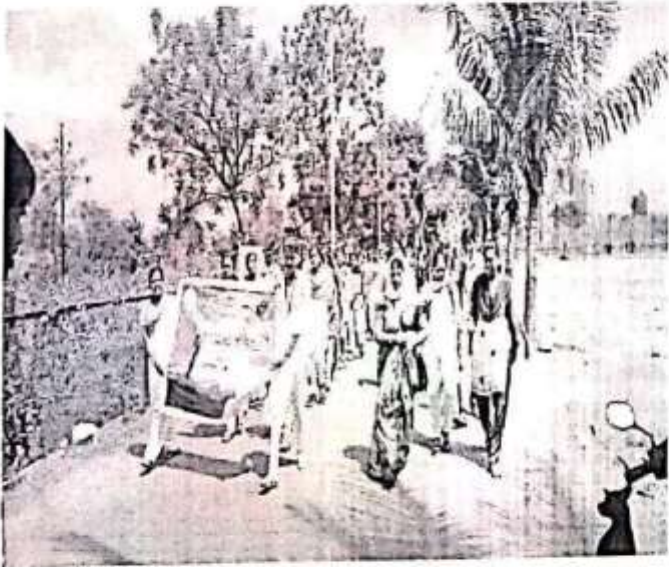



Report of 150th Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti celebrated from 24th September 2018 to 18th October 2018

Mahatma Gandhi, also known as Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi, was born on October 2, 1869, and died on January 30, 1948. He was a political and spiritual leader in India and played a key role in the Indian independence movement. Gandhi developed the novel technique of non-violent agitation, which he called "Satyagraha", loosely translated as "moral domination".

He is known for his non-violent civil disobedience in India and South Africa. These included the start of the non-cooperation movement in 1922 and the Salt *Satyagraha* or Salt (Dandi) March starting on March 12, 1930. Through Gandhi's efforts, India finally gained its freedom on August 15, 1947. The nation mourned for him after he was assassinated on January 30, 1948. The United Nations' (UN) International Day of Non-Violence is also held on October 2 each year to coincide with Mahatma Gandhi's birthday.

Mahatma Gandhi, during his life span threw a thorough light on the cleanliness and hygienicity. Cleaning plays a vital role in our daily lives, such as washing our hands before we eat or covering our mouths when we cough, or setting a standard for environmental cleanliness, effective cleaning is our first line of defense against viruses and infectious diseases. Considering the importance of overall cleanliness on the health and wealth of people the Ministry of Youth and Sports, and all other ministries of the Government of India had declared the all-inclusive cleanliness programmes in all over India. 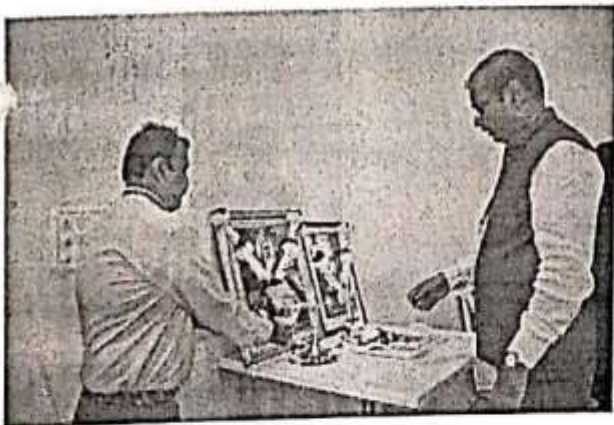
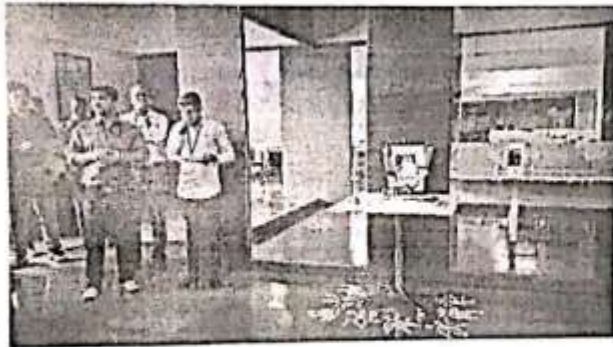
The Birth Anniversaries of following legends have been celebrated in the first semester of Academic Year 2018-19:

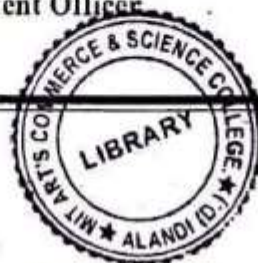

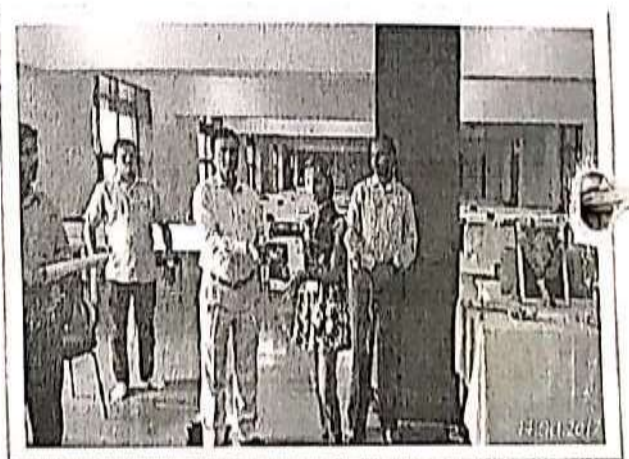

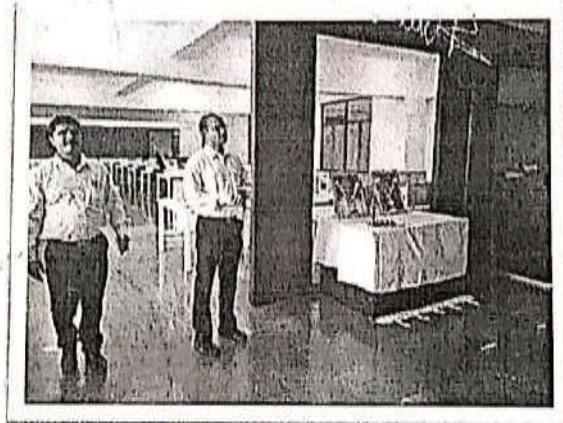
Report of 141st birth anniversary of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel observed as "Rashtriya Ekta Diwas"

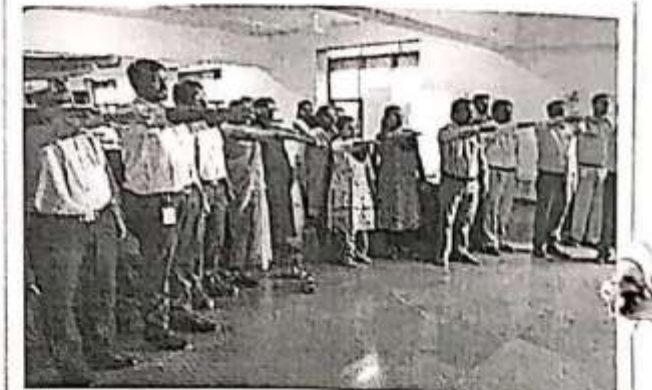
