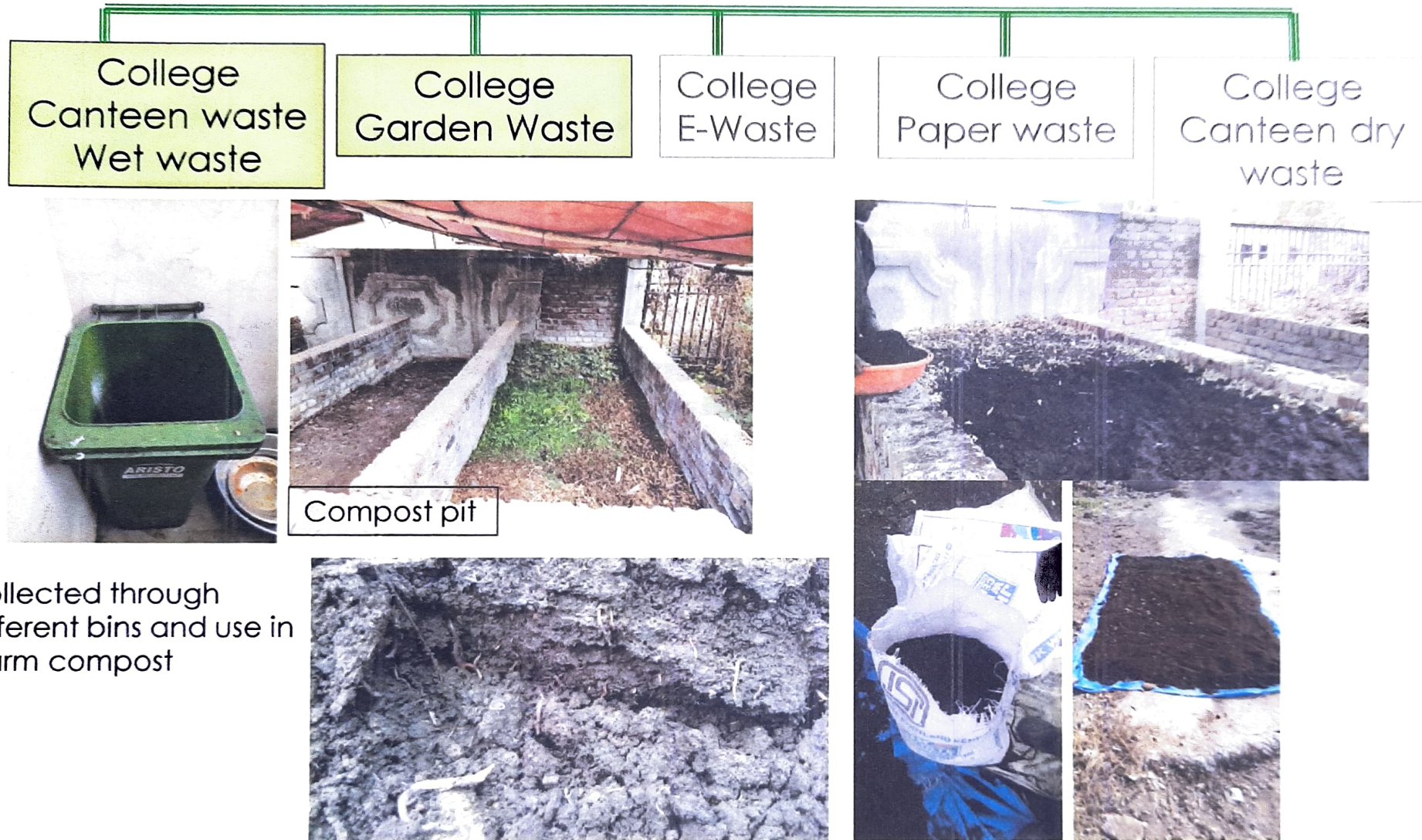

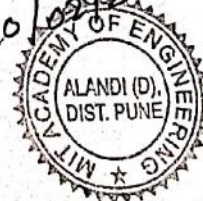

MEMORANDUM of UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter to be referred as 'MOU') is made at Pune on this 26th day of January, 2018 and shall be valid for one year from the date of first installment payment between:

TERRE Policy Centre is a Public trust, registered under the Bombay Public Trusts Act, 1950 (Bombay Act-29 of the Year 1950) in the Public Trusts Registration Office at Pune, based in 306 Multicon Square, Erandwane, Pune 411004. It is a global non-profit, non-partisan and independent organization dedicated to sustainable solutions to our developmental imperatives. TERRE also is the abbreviation for 'Technology, Education, Research and Rehabilitation for the Environment.' Hereinafter to be referred as 'TERRE' (which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors)

AND

MIT Academy of Engineering (hereinafter to be referred as 'MITAOE'); and **MIT Arts Commerce and Science College** (hereinafter to be referred as 'MITACSC') based in Dehu Phata, Alandi(D), Pune 412 105. MITAOE was established in 1999 and MITACSC was established in 2007 under MAEER by the Honorable Prof. Vishwanath D. Karad, Founder and Executive President of MIT Group. The MITAOE offers seven UG programs (B.Tech.) and three PG programs (M.Tech.) were MITACSC offers seven UG and one PG course. Recently, the UGC has honored the MITAOE with 'Academic Autonomy' considering the quality of pedagogical practices, research, faculty and the state-of-the-art infrastructure that meets global standards.

1. SUBJECT

An agreement has been reached with respect to Smart Campus Cloud Network (hereinafter to be referred as SCCN) being prepared and implemented by TERRE, Pune and to be implemented in MITAOE and MITACSC upon the signing of this MOU, which incorporates the principles of the agreement.

2. PURPOSE

The purpose of this MOU is determining the rights and obligations of the Parties, and therefore, providing a base for coordination to ensure a successful implementation and execution of the project.

This MOU is an agreement to build student participation and consultation with faculty as the core approach of the Smart campuses. The over-arching activities include but not limited to, discussion/dialogue-forum and action- platforms for campus wide energy conservation, energy efficiency, renewable energy, water conservation, waste management, sustainable mobility, sustainable consumption, and environment-friendly behavior. Partnership with business and NGOs would be the key axis around which this network will flourish.

3. ROLE OF PARTIES:

4.3 TERRE will be introducing a secured mobile app '*SCCN-CampusTime*' to enhance student engagement like never before, connecting students, faculty and other stakeholders at Campus to make SCCN live wire buzzing. *CampusTime* is an independent stand-alone mobile application with broad and extensive features encompassing all aspects of campus life. It normally charges INR 25000 for setting up, hosting and maintenance. However, for the purpose related to the objectives of SCCN, *CampusTime* has been appropriately adapted to only relevant features. *SCCN-CampusTime* would waive off the setting up, hosting and maintenance fees. Apart from acting as a discussion forum, *SCCN-CampusTime* would enable students and users to exchange an extensive experience with other students and faculties related to the objectives of SCCN. There could be a possibility to interact with the government officials and corporates in future. The Purpose of this engagement will be limited to the activities of SCCN.

The purpose of '*SCCN-CampusTime*' will:

4.3.1 Introduce new features or may cut down some features on the App from time to time without being required to seek any further approval or intimating the University/ college or users in this regard. The *SCCN-CampusTime* may launch the app to support other devices in the future. Extra features may be posted based on feedback from the campuses.

4.3.2 Any intellectual property created/generated during the course of this agreement shall belong solely to the *SCCN-CampusTime* and the University/ College shall have no right in the same whatsoever. This is however, limited to only the use and features of the *Campus Time* app, and does not relate to any Intellectual Property generated from the data being generated by users on the app, which would be the property of SCCN.

4.3.3 The App will be accessible only by the authenticated individuals.

4.3.4 The College-University campus confirms that it shall only work with **TERRE** exclusively to implement the *SCCN-CampusTime* for its use and will not partner with any other firm/ app developer that might be of conflict of interest to **TERRE** and *SCCN-CampusTime*. However, the college or **SCCN** can stop use of the *CampusTime* app with one month's notice, even in case of continued use of other **SCCN** services.

4.3.5 College campus will have an option of getting *CampusTime* App on commercial basis any time in future after 3 months of its usage.

4.3.6 **TERRE** will provide an excel sheet of Students_Data Format and Faculties_Data Format for the **MITAOE** and **MITACSC** to fill all the relevant data that would ensure their participation in *CampusTime* app. **MITAOE** and **MITACSC** will send the filled copies to **TERRE**, before availing *CampusTime* in the **MITAOE** and **MITACSC** campus.

4.4 Forming a 'SCCN Core Group':

The entire college will be participating in the **SCCN** activities and have access to the SmartSense platform. However, the **SCCN core group** will be the active members representing **MITAOE** and **MITACSC**.

MITAOE and **MITACSC** will provide a separate list of students and faculties, who will be the **SCCN Core group** members of their campus.

4.5 Scope of Educational institute - **MITAOE** and **MITACSC**:

To assist in campus boarding, lodging and local travel for expert of **TERRE** or their associates during the validity of MOU, for agreed **SCCN** activities.

5. NOTIFICATIONS:




