- To improve development outcomes as a consequence of this research. To develop new professions and new processes to sustain and absorb the outcomes of research. Etc.





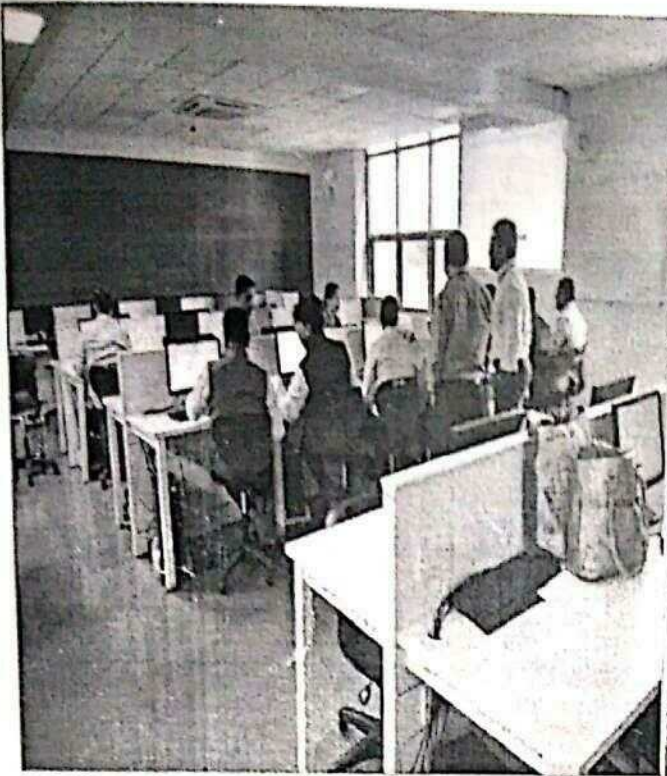
All the Faculty members from Computer Science Department participated in the content delivery of this course.

At the end of the programme fruits and sweets were distributed among the old age people.






**Exhibition: My Galaxy of MY Views : 20 December, 2018.**

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**Objective of the Activity:**




**Outcome:**

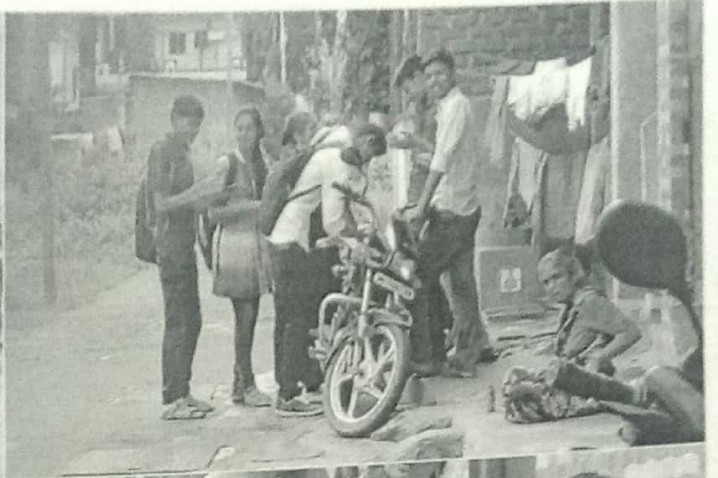

## Innovation Club Report

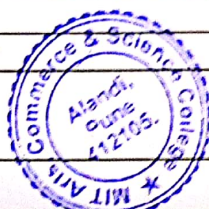

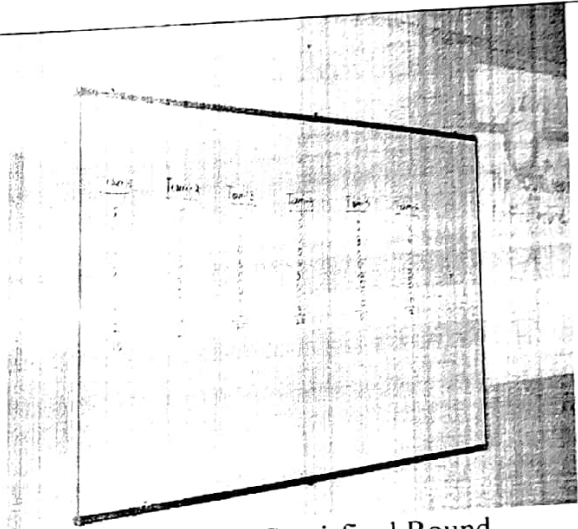

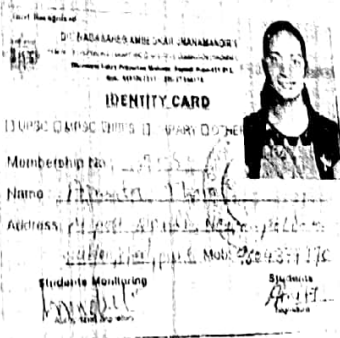

**ABOUT MODULES AND SESSIONS:**



All sessions were online and were conducted through Zoom software .First 4 sessions were arranged on every Saturday at 9.00 am and remaining 4 sessions on every Monday on same time (i.e. at 9.00 am). Total 9 students were selected for the final competition which was held on 26/02/2018 (9<sup>th</sup> week from day of commencement). The criteria for students qualifying for the competition were based on the overall performance of the student







**Session III: Saturday 10 February 2018**

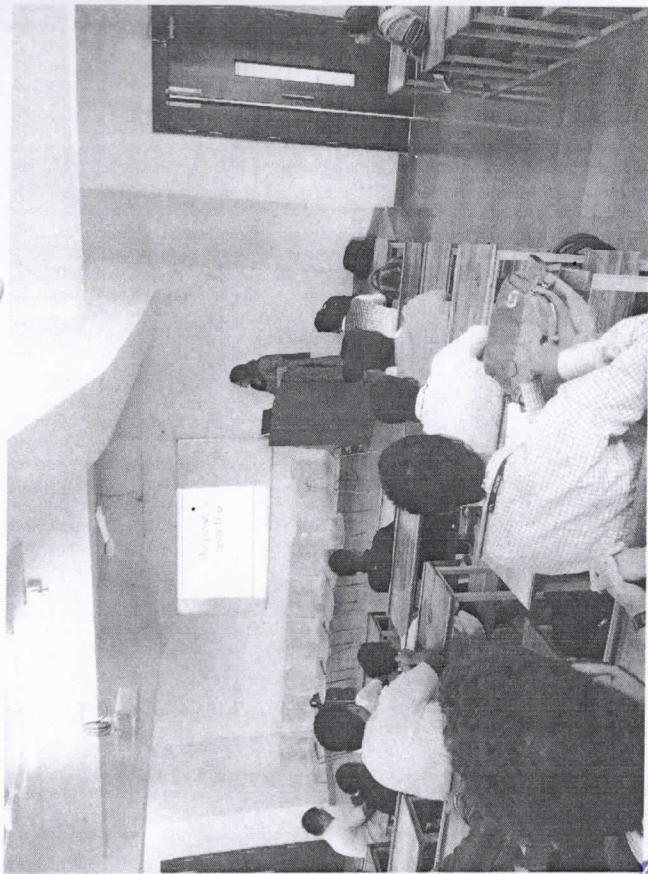

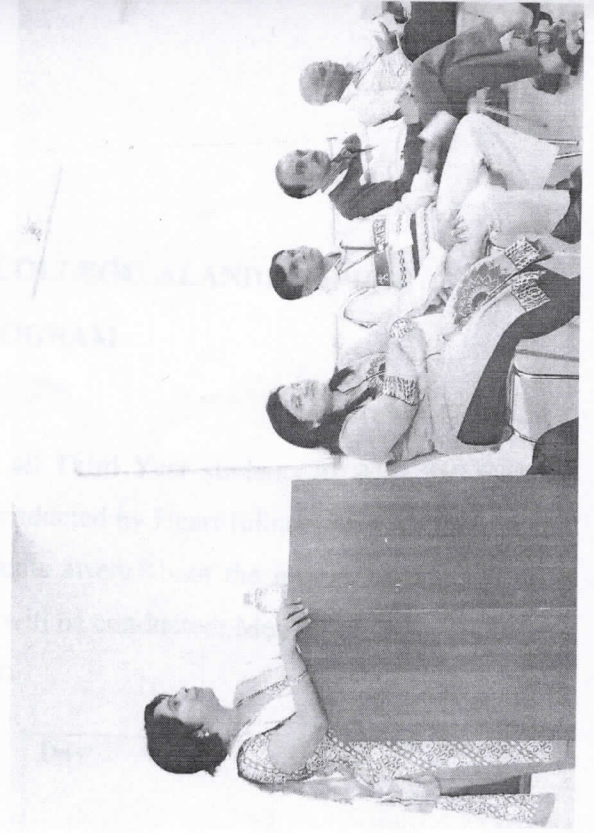
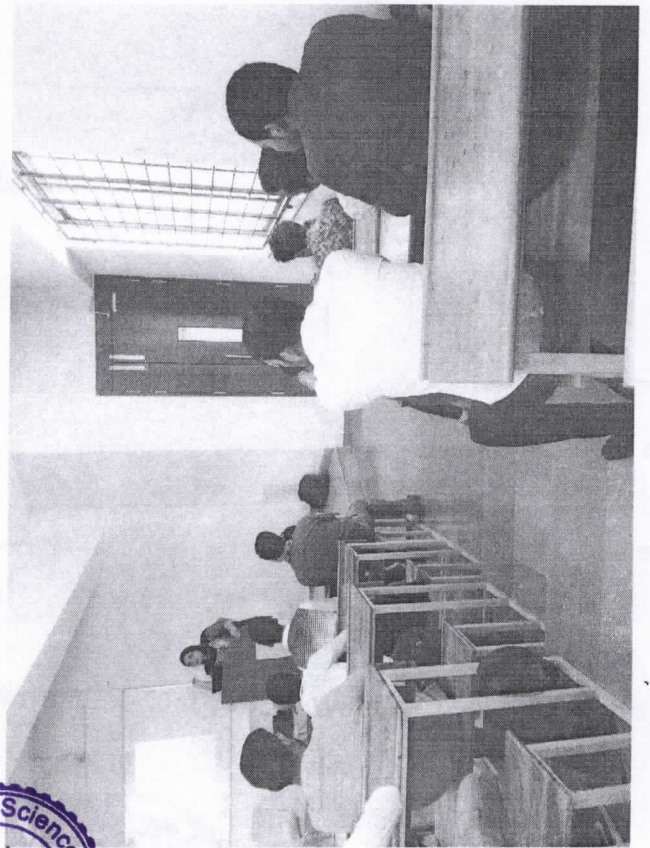

**Objective:** To bring over all shine in the student's personality, as well as a warm outlook to life and people.

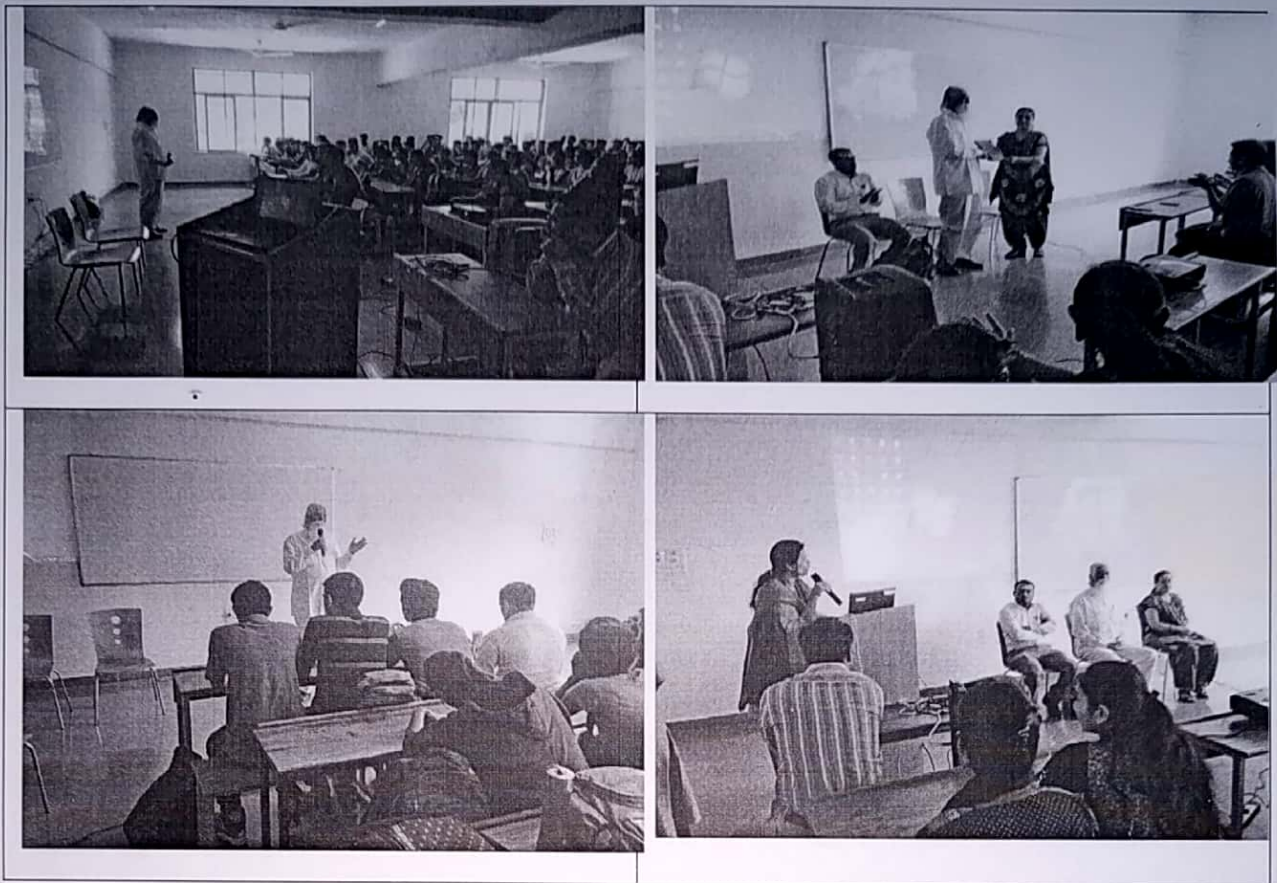

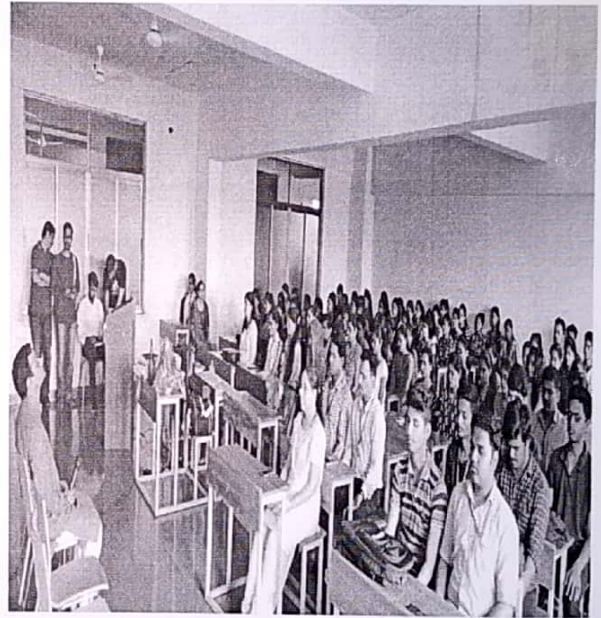
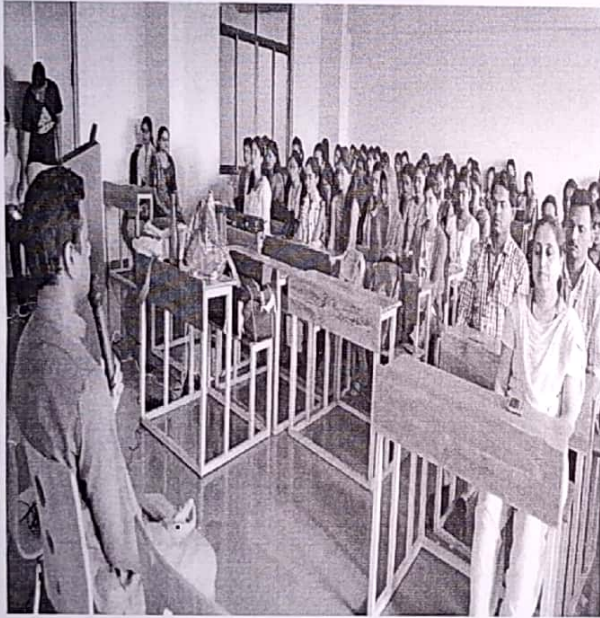
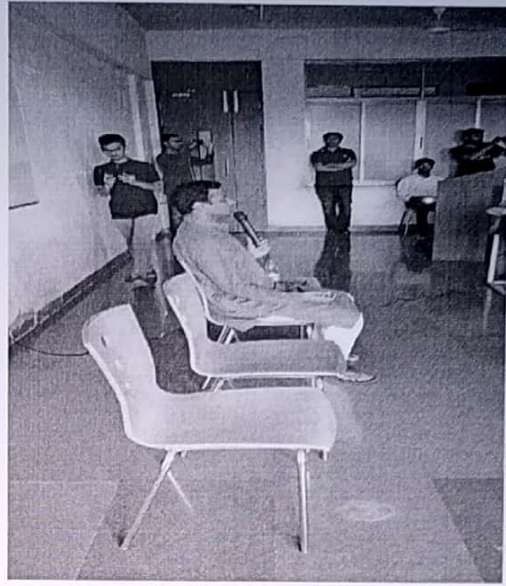
**Objective:** To build self-confidence, improve concentration and overall personality of the students.

## 6.) DOMINO EFFECT

A **domino show** is created by standing up dominoes in sequence, to create a chain reaction also called the domino effect. Only the first domino should be toppled by hand. People all over the world try to set up incredible domino projects. One of the elements of excitement of a domino show comes from the risky nature. Everybody understands that every new set up domino is another new risk to lose all of the work they have just completed. The game is normally played in pairs (two against two) and is played as a series of "ends". In each "end", the objective is for players to attach a domino from their hand to one end of those already played so that the sum of the end dominoes is divisible by five or three.

**Dominoes** is a family of boardgames played with rectangular "domino" tiles. Each domino is a rectangular tile with a line dividing its face into two square *ends*. Each end is marked with a number of spots (also called *pips*, *nips*, or *dobs*) or is blank. The backs of the dominoes in a set are indistinguishable, either blank or having some common design. The domino gaming pieces (colloquially nicknamed *bones*, *cards*, *tiles*, *tickets*, *stones*, *chips*, or *spinners*) make up a domino set, sometimes called a *deck* or *pack*. The traditional Sino-European domino set consists of 28 dominoes, featuring all combinations of spot counts between zero and six. A domino set is a generic gaming device, similar to playing cards or dice, in that a variety of games can be played with a set.

### Objectives:-

The most popular type of play are layout games, which fall into two main categories, blocking games and scoring games.

- Most domino games are blocking games, i.e. the objective is to empty one's hand while blocking the opponent's. In the end, a score may be determined by counting the pips in the losing players' hands.
- In scoring games, the scoring is different and happens mostly during game play, making it the principal objective.





### Judging Criteria:-

Before every game, a player shuffles the tiles face down on a flat playing surface, thoroughly mixing them by moving them with his hands. The player's hands may not stay on the same tiles while shuffling, and the player who does the shuffling should be the last to draw his hand for the game.

Players may choose to take turns shuffling before each game or the same player may shuffle the dominoes.

Here are two of several options: 1) The player to the right of the player making the first play does the shuffling for a game; or, 2) The winner of the previous game shuffles for the next game.

A player's position at the table in a game with three or more players is called a seat. One way to determine seating arrangements is by lot. After the tiles are shuffled, each player draws a domino from the stock. The player who draws the tile with the greatest number of pips has first choice of seats. The player holding the next highest seats himself to the left, and so on. If there is a tie, it is broken by drawing new dominoes from the stock. The tiles are returned to the stock and reshuffled before the players draw their hands. When a partnership game is played, the partners sit opposite each other.

To make this game more interesting the participants were provided with the following material.

1. Wooden blocks
2. Paper cups
3. Double side tape
4. Toothpicks
5. Plastic pipes
6. Deck cards
7. Marbles
8. Plastic balls
9. Ice-cream sticks
10. Ping pong balls/ Dancing balls
11. Wires



The participants were supposed to use the items provided by the organising team from the above list and make a chain using those items, in which the reaction would take place.

In total there were three rounds conducted.
