"Smart Placement Choices: A parent's e-workshop" was successfully organized by the Department of Arts & Commerce on Tuesday, 27th August 2024 under the guidance of Dr. Padmavati Undale, HoD Arts & Commerce. The program aimed to provide valuable insights, guidance, and strategies to effectively prepare for the career and placement opportunities of the students. This session involved collaborative discussions between teachers, the placement department, TYBCOM students and their parents.

The program started with the introduction and Welcome proposed by Prof. Pravin Kharat. He took the overview of the workshop's purpose and goals. He also explained various career opportunities after completing graduation.

- Placement department conducts one-on-one counseling sessions to understand students' career interests, strengths, and goals.
- Organizing workshops on resume writing, interview skills, and job search strategies.
- Offers training sessions on essential skills such as communication, teamwork, leadership, and technical skills relevant to various industries.
- Conduct mock interviews with feedback to help students practice and improve their interview skills.
- Provide guidance on crafting effective resumes and cover letters tailored to specific job applications.
- Assists students in finding internships and job placements that align with their career goals and academic background.
- Helps students with the application process, including job search strategies and application submissions.
- Provides ongoing support to students during their job search and placement process, including addressing any challenges they may encounter.
- Engage alumni to mentor current students, offering guidance based on their professional experiences.

Then concluding remark was delivered by Dr. Padmavati Undale, HoD Arts & Commerce. She highlighted the initiatives taken by the department for providing 100% placement assistance to the students. The "Smart Placement Choices: A Parent's E-Workshop" successfully met its objectives by providing parents with essential knowledge and tools for making informed educational decisions. The interactive format and expert guidance were effective in addressing the complexities of educational placement, though future workshops could benefit from more tailored resources and individual support.
