This program is organized to equip students with the essential skills and strategies needed to produce high-quality research papers. **Dr. Bharati Kawade** (Assistant Professor, Computer Application Dept., MIT ACSC) and **Dr. Kirtee Raskar** (Assistant Professor, Statistics Dept., MIT ACSC) was the resource person for this program.

Dr. Bharati Kawade guided students on the topic “Selection and formulation of a research problem”. She explained various aspects in research such as Definition of a research problem and its role in the research process, Criteria for a good research problem: relevance, feasibility, and originality and examples of effective research problems across various disciplines. She focused on the need and importance of selection of research problem.



Dr. Kirtee Raskar guided students on the topic “**Utilizing Data Analytics to enhance research methodologies**”. She provided insights into how data analytics can transform traditional research practices through the steps such as Data Collection and Management, use of Data Analysis Techniques. She described Challenges and Solutions in Research Analytics.
