Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>Question: Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.(Upto 500 words)</p> <p>MIT Arts, Commerce and Science College is committed to provide quality education. During the period of COVID 19 Pandemic, the college has taken measures to complete the syllabus of the courses and programs and to continue the teaching-learning process smoothly. The problems in teaching-learning process have been analyzed and solutions have been implemented to impart education through online platforms. First of all, the college technical team trained teachers to use applications available on various online platforms such as MICROSOFT TEAM, Google Meet etc. The students were also trained to use these platforms. The college provided login id and password to every individual student. WhatsApp groups were formed to be connected with them. The supportive devices and facilities required to conduct on line sessions were provided to the teachers as per their requirements. Tablets, pen tabs, headphones, Computers, Laptops were distributed among the teachers to continue teaching sessions. Technical assistance was provided to resolve the technical problems of the teachers and the students. The teachers made use of PPTs, online videos, white boards etc. to deliver course syllabus in an effective manner. Along with this, practical sessions were conducted with the help of online compilers, simulators and virtual laboratories. The teachers incorporated the new teaching methodologies, to make the understanding of the concept easy. All the teachers shared study material, question banks, assignments to the students to keep them engaged in learning process. They also advised students to refer other important portals such as e- Pathshala. Group discussions, presentations, classroom interactions were conducted to engage the students actively in the online classroom sessions.</p> <p>Regular academic updates, events' details, campus announcements and examination schedules were communicated to the students through LMS, email, WhatsApp Group. Course in charge maintained regular online classroom attendance record. Telephonic interactions were regularly conducted to be in touch with the students. Continuous assessment has been carried out and accordingly measures have been taken to achieve better learning outcomes. Evaluation of the students carried out through online quizzes, assignments, Class Tests, Term End Examination, Internal Examination through LMS.</p> <p>The college smoothly conducted the academic activities by adopting the new age teaching learning technology tools. The college has taken membership of Spoken Tutorial -a project by IIT Bombay and students are admitted to the various online certificate courses offered by it. Students are also motivated to register and complete online courses offered by SWAYAM and NPTEL as supportive courses to their academic. They are also guided to refer online courses offered by other online platforms such as Course era, Udemy etc.</p> <p>Teaching learning plays an important role in the lives of both preceptor and disciples, so in spite of facing the critical situation of pandemic around, the college honestly made sure that every student should be benefitted with the online teaching learning process.</p>
